Tuition fees are charged on per student basis with discount rates applicable to families with more than one student attending the College

The fees are all inclusive and cover compulsory curriculum based activities, camps and excursions, ID card, College provided course materials and loan of an ICT device to students.

Timing for Issue of Tax Invoice

A single tax invoice for the full amount of 2021 tuition fees will be issued in early December 2020. Please note that it will be the only tax invoice issued for 2021 tuition fees. Receipts and monthly statements are available for viewing/printing on the College Community Portal (“Portal”).

Payment Plans

Marcellin offers a choice of three Payment Plans to pay tuition fees –

Plan 1 - a single payment on or before 15 February 2021

Plan 2 - two equal payments on or before 15 February 2021 and 15 July 2021 respectively

Plan 3 - ten equal monthly payments on the 15th of each month from February 2021 to November 2021

Where the 15th of the month is a weekend or public holiday, automatic deductions will be processed on the next business day.

New families will have the opportunity to select a Payment Plan. Existing families will default to their 2020 payment plan for payment of 2021 fees and will have the opportunity to change their payment plan if desired.

Payment Methods and Discounts

The College prefers families to pay tuition fees by automatic deduction from credit card or bank account and offers a discount for payments made on this basis. Alternatively, families may administer their own payments to the College and can receive a discount for Payment Plan 1 only.

The following table shows the discount applicable for each payment option -

Please note the following with regard to discounts -

- The discounts offered in 2021 apply to the 2021 academic year only and may be subject to change in future years;
- Entitlement to a fee discount exists once the last instalment is paid. Recipients of a 2021 College bursary will not be entitled to receive any discount in 2021;
- Any account with an overdue balance at the end of 2020 will not be entitled to a discount in 2021 unless the overdue balance is fully paid by the time the final instalment of 2021 tuition fees is paid; and
- Discounts are issued as a reduction of the final fee payable or as a credit to the account and provided all instalments of the nominated payment plan are paid by their due date.

Other Charges

The following charges are payable in addition to tuition fees -

- Optional Camps, Excursions and Programs;
- Library Charges – late fees and replacement costs;
- Laptop repairs (not covered by warranty);
- Instrumental Music Tuition & Instrument Hire; and
- Public Speaking Tuition.

Tax Invoices for these charges will be issued separately to the invoice issued for tuition fee billings. Payments of these charges are due within 14 days of receipt of a tax invoice and cannot be paid by incorporating them into the tuition fee Payment Plans.

Families that are bursary recipients or that are in arrears on payment of tuition fees are ineligible to participate in co-curricular activities that incur an additional cost.

Bursary Program

We acknowledge and accept that the vast majority of parents and guardians make sacrifices to provide their boys with a Marcellin education. However, it never has or will be the College's desire that parents or guardians reach the point of financial distress to meet the cost of sending their boys to Marcellin.

The College bursary program to assist those in financial need will continue in 2021. Applications are sought from all families whose payment of Marcellin fees exceeds 11% of their gross family income. However there is no commitment that this will be the trigger point for entitlement to a bursary or that any bursary application will be successful.

Withdrawal of Students

Parents or guardians must provide written notice of at least one term if their son is leaving the College. Otherwise one quarter of the scheduled annual tuition fee is payable in lieu of notice.

Conditions of Enrolment

Students' enrolments are also subject to the Conditions Of Enrolment signed by Parents/Guardians. Copies can be requested from the College Registrar.
